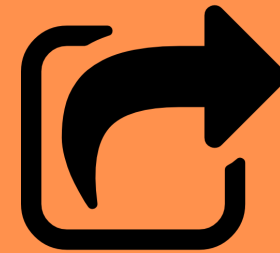
Everyone can use these housing resources, regardless of immigration status, without creating problems with the public charge rule.

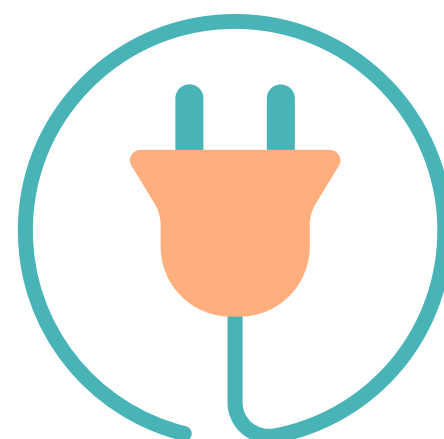
Community Based Organizations
