ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR INITIAL DACA APPLICATIONS

□ Born on or after June 16, 1981
☐ Came to the United States before reaching your 16th birthday
\square Have continuously resided in the U.S. since June 15, 2007 up to the present time
☐ If previously deported, ordered removed, or left the US during this period, DISCUSS WITH AN
IMMIGRATION ATTORNEY
\square Were physically present in the United States on June 15, 2012, and at the time of making DACA application
\square Entered without inspection, or lawful immigration status expired as of June 15, 2012
\square Are currently in school, have graduated from high school, or obtained a general education certificate (GED)
\square Have NOT been convicted of a felony, significant misdemeanor, three or more other misdemeanors, and do
not otherwise pose a threat to national security or public safety
$\hfill\square$ If you have any arrests or criminal convictions, DISCUSS WITH AN IMMIGRATION ATTORNEY
☐ Be at least 15 years old to file an application (unless you are or have been in deportation proceedings)

EXAMPLES OF DOCUMENTS TO PROVE ELIGIBILITY

(We strongly recommend that you discuss your case with an immigration attorney or accredited representative before submitting any documentation to the government)
