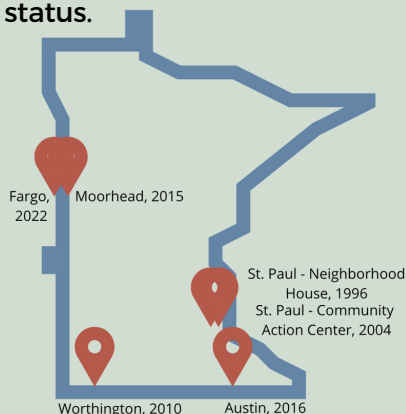
Values

Unique Attributes

- ILCM is the only legal program in Minnesota that provides comprehensive immigration services to low-income persons of all nationalities regardless of legal status.



Clients

- In 2021, ILCM served clients coming from 102 countries, with 41% from Mexico, 17% from countries in Central and South America, 20% from countries in Asia, 18% from countries in Africa, and the remainder from countries in Europe, Oceania, and North America.
- In 2021, ILCM served clients living in 68 counties in Minnesota.

Fargo

- Roughly 5% of North Dakota's population was born in another country, while another 5% are native-born U.S. citizens with at least one immigrant parent. (American Immigration Council)
- Immigrants are an integral part of the North Dakota workforce in a range of occupations. In 2018, 25,558 immigrant workers comprised 6% of the labor force. (American Immigration Council)
- Immigrants also play a key role in the economy. According to a recent InForum article ("Fargo-Moorhead area employers urged to invest in refugee, immigrant workers", 2021), new Americans in the region paid \$13.8 million in state and local taxes in 2014 and contributed \$542.8 million to the region's gross domestic product.

ILCM's Fargo Office

- ILCM's Fargo office is open Monday and Tuesday, 9:00am-4:00pm.
- Our Fargo office can assist refugees, asylees, Cuban parolees, Afghan parolees, and Ukrainian parolees with:
 - Adjustment of status (I-485 green card application)
 - Citizenship application (N-400)
 - Employment authorization card (I-765) initial or replacement
 - I-90 application to replace lost or stolen green card

ILCM Success



In 2021, ILCM provided legal services in 3,092 unique cases impacting approximately 9,276 individuals.

159 pro bono attorneys donated over 3,131 hours of service to ILCM clients and their families.
