Driver's Licenses Timeline ILCM Fact Sheet

If I have a Minnesota (or any other State) Driver's Licenses that is:

Unexpired - Less than one year expired

- Provide primary and secondary documents to ensure record is correct
 - Name change documents are necessary when the name listed on your primary document is different than your current legal name (what will be listed on your Driver's License or ID)
- No knowledge exam required
- No skill exam required

Less than one year expired - five years expired

- Provide primary and secondary documents to ensure record is correct
 - Name change documents are necessary when the name listed on your primary document is different than your current legal name (what will be listed on your Driver's License or ID)
- Knowledge exam required
- No skill exam required

Over five years expired

- Provide primary and secondary documents to ensure record is correct
 - Name change documents are necessary when the name listed on your primary document is different than your current legal name (what will be listed on your Driver's License or ID)
- Knowledge exam required
- Skill exam required
 - If your card is expired >5 years, you can take ONE skill exam using that as your proof of driving privileges.
 - A pass means you don't have to wait the permit time.
 - A fail means you will have to obtain a permit and practice.
