## Mission

The Immigrant Law Center of Minnesota enhances opportunities for immigrants and refugees through legal representation for low-incomes individuals, and through education and advocacy with diverse communities.

## Our Offices

ILCM has offices in Austin, Moorhead, St. Paul, and Worthington Minnesota.

In 2022, ILCM opened an office in Fargo, North Dakota to provide services to refugees, asylees, and new arrivals from Afghanistan and Ukraine.



## Our Work

- Represent individuals and families in legal matters to obtain, improve, and preserve legal status – such as DACA for Dreamers, VAWA and U Visas for survivors of violence, deportation defense for those detained, and citizenship for green card holders
- Educate immigrants, professionals, and the general community about immigration and the issues faced by immigrants and refugees
- Advocate for fair and just policies that support immigrant and refugee communities at the federal, state, and local levels

## Clients

- ILCM served clients coming from 102 countries, with 37% from Mexico, 18% from countries in Central and South America, 20% from countries in Asia, 16% from countries in Africa, and the remainder from countries in Europe, Oceania, and North America.
- ILCM served clients living in 65 Minnesota counties.



ILCM provided legal services in 3,033 unique cases impacting over 9,000 individuals.

70 pro bono attorneys donated 2,654 hours of service to ILCM clients and their families.
