<b>Notes</b>	Brief Advice: up to 300% FPG · Full Representation: 200% FPG Minnesota residents only. Capacity based on pro-bono attorneys
<b>Case Types</b>	Family Petitions, Green Card, Citizenship, DACA, Employment Authorization (I-765), T/U visas, VAWA petitions, government benefits for immigrants, general immigration legal advise

<b>Case Types</b>	General immigration consultations — attorneys can advise on a wide range of immigration matters
<b>Notes</b>	Hub organizations: The Advocates for Human Rights, ILCM, MMLA, Southern MN Regional Legal Services, and VLN. For rural MN residents only. Meet with an attorney virtually for free 20–30 minute consultation.
